**DEFIBRILLATOR APPEAL** - Thank you very much to all who contributed towards a public access defibrillator to be sited at St James. Thanks to the support of the church congregations, local community, small businesses and Baildon Town Council, we able to purchase a fully automatic defib, pay for fitting and have a contingency fund for replacement components and upkeep. So the funding appeal is now closed. Next steps are Diocesan permission and site visit, aiming to have the defib in situ asap. Your gift is potentially life saving. Thank you! **TRIBUTE NIGHTS** - In November 2023 and February 2024 Loraine organised two very successful Tribute nights in the parish which were well supported and enjoyed. However, it has been discovered that the previously published total for the November night was incorrect, for which I apologise, but I am still delighted to say that it raised £959.21. The February night raised a great total of £927.90. We are grateful to Loraine for her hard work.

**LENT LUNCHES** - As in previous years, Baildon churches are offering a simple lunch during Lent. The dates and venue are in the Lent booklet.

**MESSY CHURCH** - our next Messy Church session is Sunday 17th March at 4pm in St John's Church Hall. All families welcome.

JAR OF GRACE FOR UNICEF - Once again this year our Lent appeal is for the work of UNICEF. They say on their website 'UNICEF works in over 190 countries and territories to save children's lives, to defend their rights, and to help them fulfil their potential, from early childhood through adolescence. And we never give up.' I am sure, like me, you think this is invaluable work and so we are using their Jar of Grace Appeal to raise funds for their work. We will collect these in on Easter Sunday and in April.

**APCM -** Our annual meeting is on 8th April at 7.30pm in St John's Church Hall and everyone is welcome. We will review 2023 and look forward to the coming year.
